Emergency Food Boxes

- ◆ In March— we packed 399 Food Boxes! Everyone enjoys helping pack rice, beans, sugar and etc. The little children take great joy in carrying each finished bag to the assembly line!

Hygiene Kit Packs

- ◆ In April— we had a Hygiene Kit pack which consisted of bath towels, hand towels, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, comb, fingernail clippers, razor and bar soap. An enthusiastic group of people neatly packed each bag. We also showed some slides from Christian Aid Ministries' Open House.

Clothes Packing

- ◆ A Clothes Packing was held in June— a total of 62 bags of clothing were sorted and packed along with 4 bags of shoes. These bags are then shipped back to CAM's warehouse and sent overseas wherever the greatest need is—usually they are distributed to the poor people who live in Haiti and Romania.

School Kit Bags

- ◆ For the month of July— there was a School Kit pack at the pavilion where we placed notebooks, rulers, pencils, pens, erasers and color crayons in a colorful bag. A total of 500 bags were assembled, and will be sent to CAM for distribution where needed most.

Dried Fruit Pack

- ◆ Come join us! We have planned a dried fruit & nut packing—Thursday, August 19th at 7pm at Root Farm's NEW warehouse located on Bangs Ave.

Cookie & Candy Pack

- ◆ In December—we make cookies or candy and bring them to be placed in bags, which then go to Salvation Army for the Christmas dinner they put on each year.

Operation Christmas Child

- ◆ The young folks are planning to have their 6th Annual trip to Los Angeles in the first part of December, for Samaritan Purse's shoe box sorting.

Modesto Gospel Mission

- ◆ Several people volunteer to make & serve food at the Mission on the first Saturday night of each month, as well as conduct the Devotion Service— which all the people have to attend if they want to eat supper.
- ◆ The young folks help out the first Friday night of each month at the "Gate Night," where young adults gather to play basket ball, fuse ball and card games.

To Whom It May Concern:

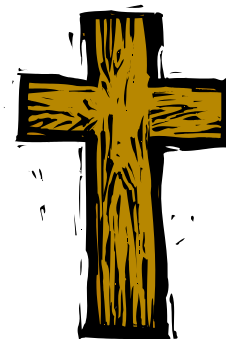

No Greater Joy Ministries has given us contact information with several prison chaplains in California. Chaplain Lance from the prison in Merced requested 400 Good & Evil books for the inmates in his prison! He drove to Randy Jenkins' office and picked up the 16 cases of Good & Evil books on July 8th.

The Chaplain from the McFarland prison inquired for 494 Good & Evil books, and a former Lamb Board member delivered them directly to the prison on July 14th.

Just last week, we received mail from the prison in McFarland that included pictures of the books all spread out, ready to give to the inmates, along with 4 pages full of signatures & thank you's from the inmates who received a copy of the Good & Evil book. One man said, "Thank you very much for the books you sent us. We appreciate them from our hearts. God Bless!"

For many, many prisoners this book is like a Gift from God... because they do not have money to buy any books, and there's not hardly any Christian material available for them to read, either!

Several families met at Randy & Sarah Jenkins home on Monday, June 28th to prepare the first 100 books to mail to prisoners.

Before we began, we stopped to offer a prayer for God to bless our efforts in sending out

the books, and that each person would come to know Christ as their personal Savior through the gospel story the books clearly portray.

Each person gladly participated in the work. The men were greatly appreciated for moving

the heavy 50lb. boxes from the truck to the table and back again! We put a slip of paper in the front of each book with the words that "This book has been provided by LAMB Services," along with our address & "May the Lord bless you as you read this book."
